General Data Protection Act

Your email will not be kept unless you email me asking to sign up for one year's paid-for editions. In that case your email will be kept for a year. At the end of the year you will be given the option of resubscribing. If you choose to do so your email address will be kept by me for as long as you subscribe. If you choose not to continue subscribing then I will delete your email address.

I will also delete any financial details you send me to subscribe except any information I am obliged to keep by the UK Inland Revenue (IR) to show my sources of annual income. I am obliged to keep this information for a period set by IR but this information will not be shared with anyone except IR and only if they ask for it. Re: Cookies I don't personally use these but the company which administers the site for me (Wix) does, mainly for security reasons and to keep the site running smoothly .
